OLDER-EU / Visit of the Repos de Pro and Le Condorcet

EHPAD (nursing home) and temporary accommodation

1. A few words about the establishments

1.1 Le Repos de Procé



The Le Repos de Procé residence is located not far from the town center and a few steps from the Parc de Procé. Surrounded by pleasant green spaces, less than 200 m from the Parc de Procé, residents enjoy a serene and green setting.

EHPAD (Nursing home): The nursing home is a complete solution and respects the privacy of seniors. It offers an all-inclusive day price: accommodation, catering, care, gaily life services, entertainment, etc.

Open for more than 35 years, the residence was renovated in 2012. It accommodates 88 autonomous, semi-valid and dependent elderly people and also has a PASA (Adapted Care and Activities Center) for people with the disease. Alzheimer's or other related disorders.

Each accommodation consists of a living room, a kitchenette and an adapted bathroom. The accommodations for couples have an additional bedroom and their area is 50 m².

Each employee strives to create a privileged relationship in his professional gesture with the resident, which helps to animate life:

- Care and assistance with hygiene gestures, cocooning and balneotherapy
- Snack time, board games and sharing a few musical notes
- Help with meals and respect for food tastes and habits

Similarly, the "Filles de Mères" group, which actively participates in the life of the house, creates weekend events such as: Telethon, oyster tasting, picnic in the garden, concert of the university choir, Christmas decorations, ...

1.2 Le Condorcet



The Le Condorcet residence is located in a quiet and pleasant area. Just like the Repos de Procé, Le Condorcet benefits from a very pleasant environment.

Temporary stay: this structure of 41 accommodations articulates its life project on the encouragement of autonomy and the socialization of the resident. The causes of a need for temporary accommodation can be varied: following hospitalization, loneliness, need for rest, children's holidays, respite for carers, etc. Depending on the needs, the duration of our reception varies from 3 days to 3 months. .





The residents occupy an individual furnished apartment. Each accommodation is equipped with an emergency call device, a fire detector, a private bathroom, a rest chair, a television, and a direct telephone line.

Animations can take different forms:

- Animations in small groups with the residents which vary according to the weather, the interest of the people, their mobility, their communication system.
- Activities for everyone with the intervention of outside contributors (musicians, singers, gym teachers, memory workshops, visiting dogs, etc.).

Support for acts of daily living is provided by our team of caregivers present 24/7 and from Monday to Sunday our team of nurses provides nursing care.

The Condorcet has established a large number of partnerships with health professionals and health structures in order to meet the significant care needs of people at home or discharged from hospital.

2. The place of these establishments in the continuum of service and support

In France, the accompaniment of the elderly has known in recent years a political and operational orientation which tends towards home care.

This political will responds to the majority wish of the French to age at home, in a familiar environment. Many systems are therefore organized around this new paradigm. However, given the issues of high level of dependency, social isolation, etc. not all elderly people can stay at home.

It is within the framework of the service and support continuum that VYV3 sets up a set of establishments and services adapted to the support of the elderly.

The temporary stay is an opportunity for the elderly to find a place of respite, allowing a variable length of stay (between 3 days and 3 months). This offer allows the beneficiary to organize a transition between major phases of life. This offer provides complete support for people coming from home and wishing to return there, enhanced support for people leaving hospital before returning home or even is aimed at people who can no longer stay at home and who are thus preparing their entry into permanent accommodation in an EHPAD.

The EHPAD is a solution that has existed in its current form for about 20 years in France. These establishments tend to evolve over the past 5 to 10 years towards supporting an extremely dependent public. The EHPAD benefits from an organization and professionals allowing it to implement geriatric expertise guaranteeing quality support for dependent elderly people. The increasing prevalence of neuro-evolutionary diseases (Alzheimer's type) requires these establishments to renew themselves and adapt to the specific needs of the people concerned.

The connection between these establishments on the same site provides real consistency in terms of the continuum. The complementarity of the 2 establishments offers an ability to offer real care, support and life projects to the elderly.

This junction makes it possible to create a real link between the establishments and this offers a possibility of interaction and exchange between the residents of the 2 establishments. The Projects of the 2 establishments complement each other and offer a perspective of continuity of support for the elderly.
